Hunting Corner

Any 2 deer at CECO can be harvested as per IDNR permits in possession for all seasons. NO rifles except muzzleloaders can be used on CECO property for deer.

All CECO deer hunters must receive and wear their CECO hunting buttons while hunting on CECO property. Buttons will be available at the fall R&G club meeting. Bring a copy of your IDNR deer tag(s) to the meeting or mail a self-addressed stamped envelope to Paul Horvatin, 813 Lincoln St., Downers Grove, IL 60515. Please write your email address and CECO membership number on your permit copy.

All tree stands and game cameras must have your CECO number attached and be visible at ground level. Ground blinds shall have 400 square inches of blaze orange or pink visible on all sides when <u>occupying</u> the blind. Blinds left up overnight must have members name and number fixed to the blind. Stands and blinds must maintain a 100 yard distance from other stands. As has been the practice, stand owners have first right to their stand. Stands and game cameras that do not have member name and membership number by will be removed from CECO property.

Fishing Update

Our fisheries biologist conducted an assessment of our Main Lake and Shawnee again this year.



Results in Shawnee were very encouraging—bass and bluegill both appear to be doing well. We will keep an eye on the crappie population, which appears to be decreased. We will also keep an eye on the increased pike population, but it doesn't appear to be a concern at this point.

The Main Lake continues to be a challenge due to a weak food chain. The bluegill we're stocking is the primary forage base, especially for the largemouth bass. And while it may appear there are abundant bluegill in the lake, they're not producing enough spawn and we're seeing underfed bass. Other species seem to be doing better. We continue to see good numbers of healthy walleye.
